



1. On the Home screen, click on an account to view a listing of the details and transaction history associated with the account.

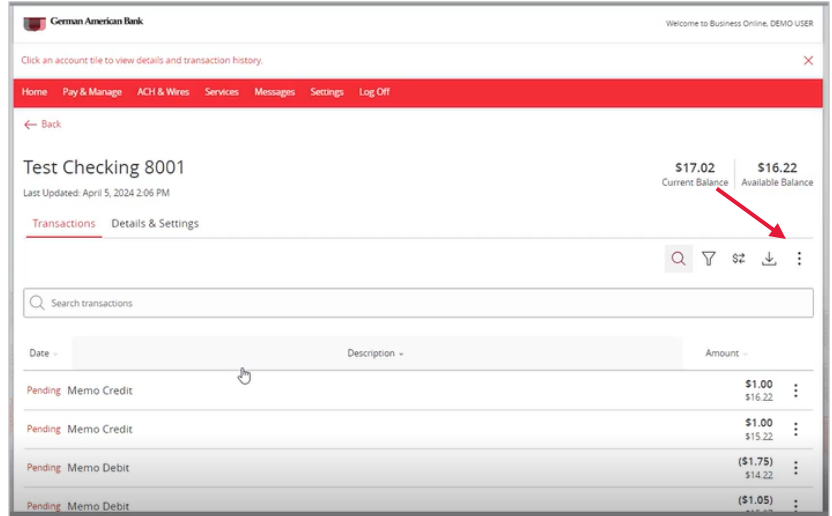

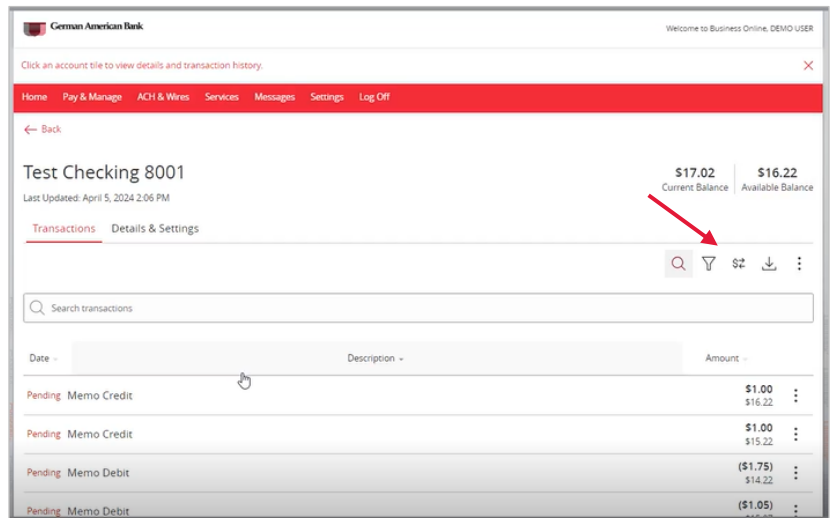

2. Select the Export icon to display a listing of available formats. The export will include all transactions specified in the filter by the user.

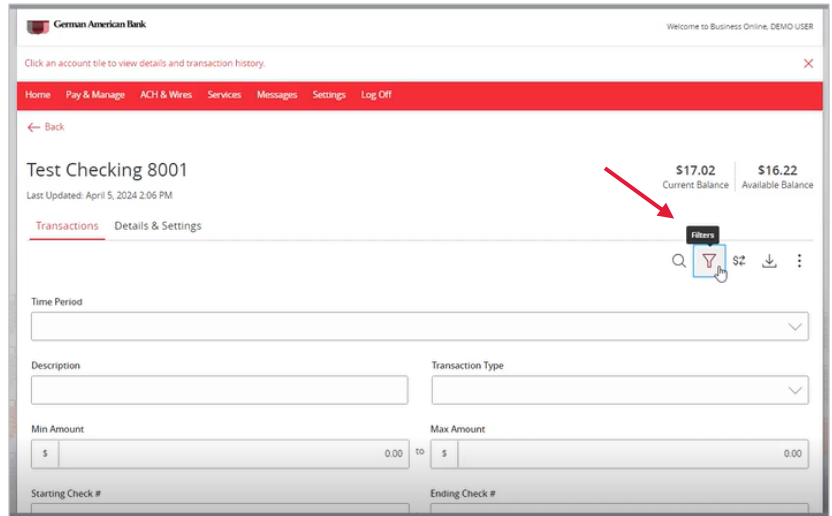


3. Select the 'Quick Transfer' to complete a transfer.

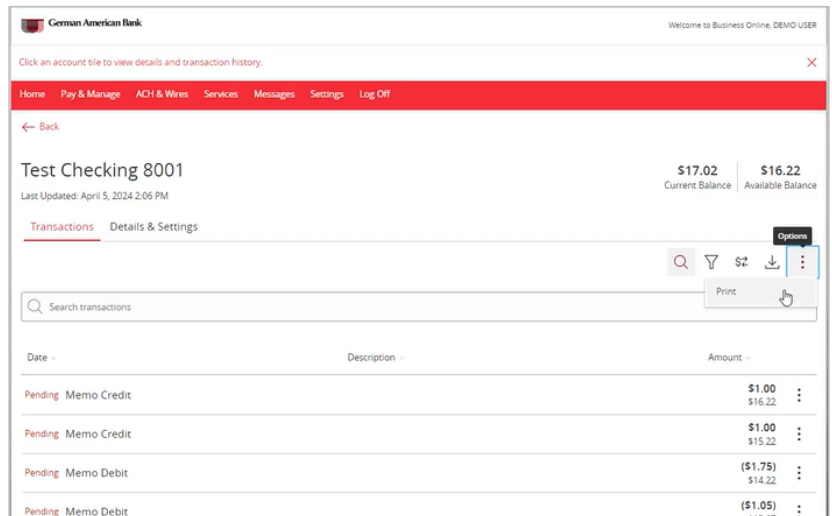




4. Select the 'Filters' icon to view the various search criteria for transaction history.

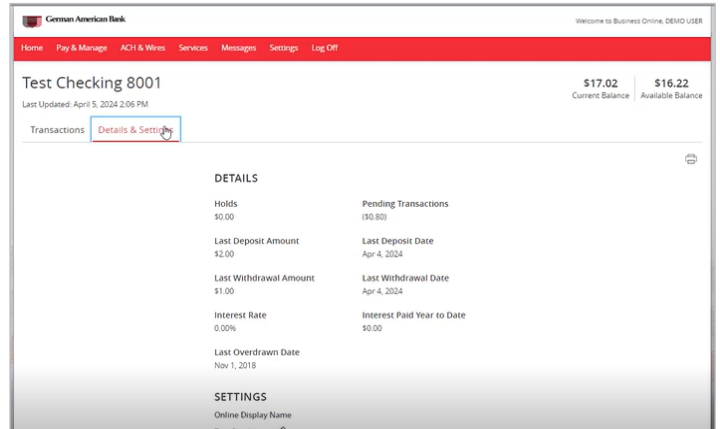


5. Select 'Options' to display available actions.
